

# CARING FOR YOUR TERRARIUM



Terrariums recycle their moisture and thus, need very little attention. Once the right humidity balance is established, a closed terrarium can often go a month or more between watering.

- \* Check every couple of weeks to see if your terrarium needs water. Feel the soil for dryness and add water if it is. Spritz lightly with a spray bottle.
- \* Keep in a bright area, but not in direct sunlight.
- \* Take off the top of a closed terrarium at least once a month to air it out. Leave the top off for a chance to dry out if there is a lot of condensation.
- \* Deadhead yellowed leaves, prune plants if they grow too large, and removed rotted plants. Rot is often associated with too much moisture.
- \* Over time, “refresh” the soil. Replace the top layers of soil with fresh potting soil.
- \* Never fertilize your terrarium.
