CYCLAMEN

Flowering Period:

Flowers fall-winter. Plant goes dormant spring-summer. Place in a cool location and gradually reduce watering after flowering period is over. Let rest two to three months, watering **very** infrequently. In late summer, repot corm in fresh soil and place in a warm area to promote root growth. Eventually place plant back into a sunny location.

Light:

Must have three to four hours direct sun to keep producing new flowers

Water:

Allow soil to dry slightly between thorough soakings. Avoid pouring water directly in center of plant so as not to rot the corm from which it grows. Fertilize every two weeks with an all purpose fertilizer during active growing period, fall through winter.
