Flowering Period:

Spring and summer, but the Calamondin Orange can produce flower and fruit nearly year round.

Light:

Bright light is essential; must have three to four hours of direct sun. Choose the sunniest spot available. Should spend summers outdoors.

Water:

Keep evenly moist. Must have good drainage and consistent watering. Mist leaves occassionally. Fertilize monthly during the growing season with an all purpose houseplant fertilizer. May repot in spring, if necessary.
