

Deer Resistant Plants

Damage from browsing deer is most severe in winter when food is at a premium, and in early spring when new growth emerges from plants. Deer will eat any vegetation when hungry, but there are certain plants that are less susceptible to deer damage. Also, remember when using deer repellents to alternate brands so that the deer do not become accustomed to certain scents.
