

AMARYLLIS

Flowering Period:

Blooms 4 to 6 weeks in winter. After the flowers have faded, continue with light water and fertilizer until foliage turns yellow (in late spring), then store the potted bulb in a cool dry place for several months. In the fall when the new growth appears, bring plant back into light and start regular watering and feeding.

Light:

Bright indirect light from a south, east, or west window.

Water:

Keep evenly moist during the growing period. Water thoroughly when soil feels dry across the surface of the pot. Fertilize monthly during the active growing period.
