

Fairy Gardens

1. Fill the bottom inch of your container with gravel. Then, cover the gravel with potting soil. Leave about one inch of space between the edge of your container and the soil.

2. Place your large pieces, such houses and plants, first. Simple birdhouses can be transformed into beautiful fairy houses. The size of your plants depends on the size of your garden area - mini plants, succulents, and bonsai work great!

3. Cover your remaining exposed soil with stone. Be creative - make stone paths and rivers from different colors, or a real mini water feature.

4. Add miniature decor, including furniture, insects, gnomes and/or fairies.

*Remember to keep your plants watered and trimmed
